Sub: GSC strongly condemns the illegal demolition of houses of Sikhs and Langar Hall of Gurdwara in Gagan Manoharpur village Moradabad UP.

In a country where crores of people are undernourished and struggle for a single meal in a day, Gurdwaras are doing what every ideal government should have been doing. It is very strange that the authorities instead of supporting the philanthropic cause of the Sikh community members living in Gagan Manoharpur village, near Moradabad UP for more than 50 years have not only demolished the houses of some Sikh families but also the Langar Hall of the Gurdwara.
